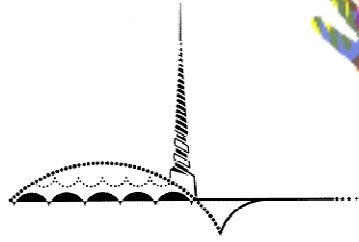

3/1 to 3/4 – Canal Alliance – Census presentations will take place during English and business classes. Visit www.canalalliance.org for details.

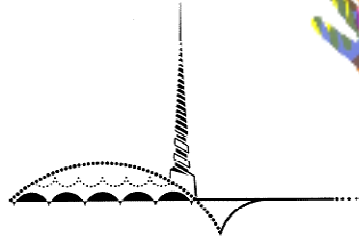
3/1 to 3/5 – San Anselmo Police Department – Census information posted on Nixie which is the web based site used to spread information to the community.
